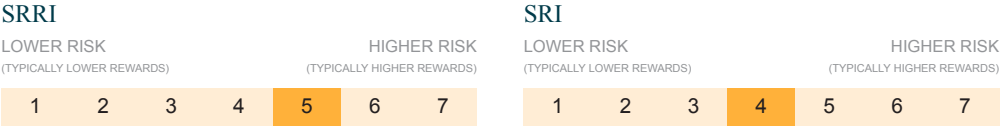

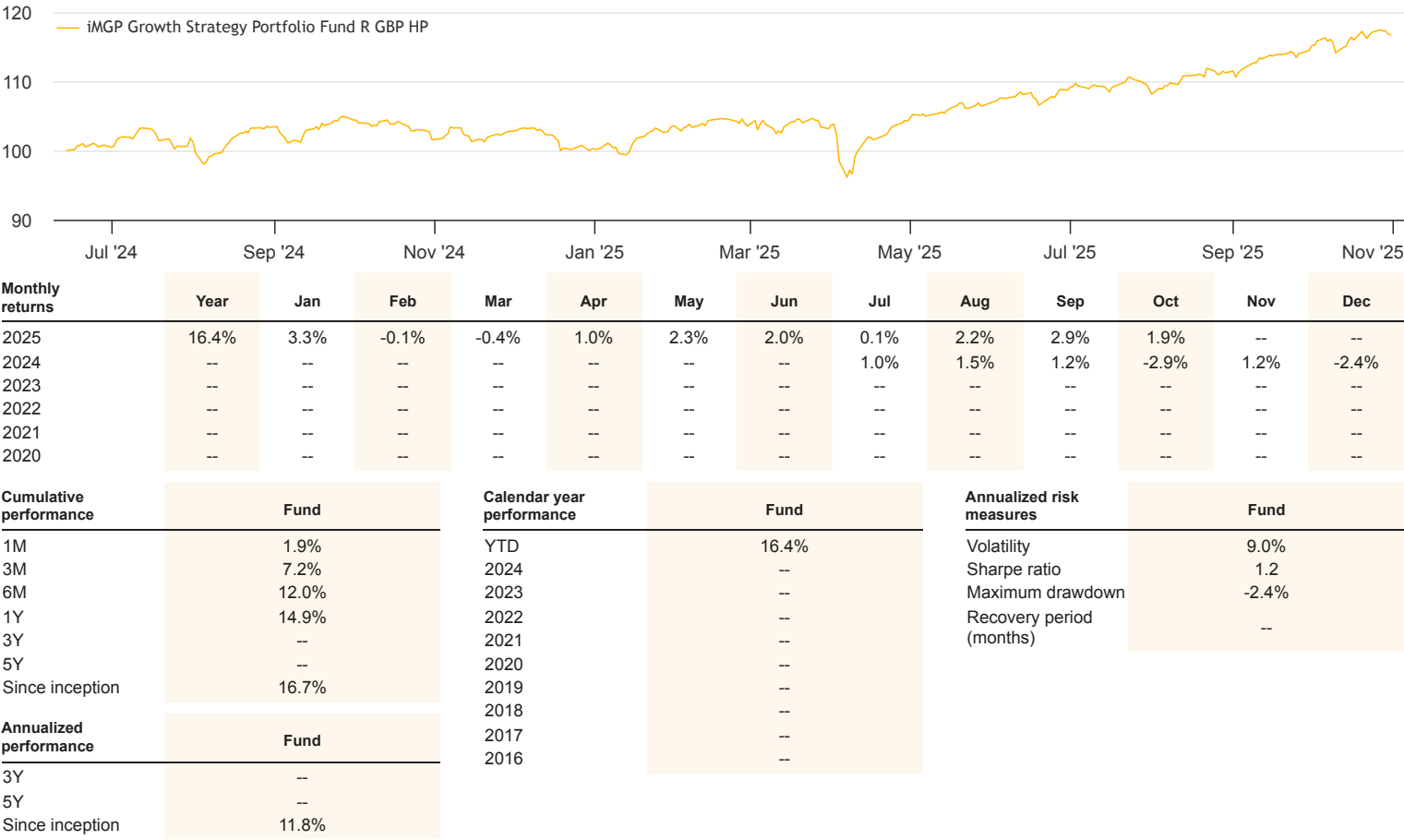
Risk/Return profile of the share class

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Fund manager Comment

Highlights

-Global Equities have continued to grind higher, making new highs in October and delivering almost 2% in USD terms The technology focused Mag-7 led markets higher, with financials and insurance the biggest detractors in October Gold rose 4% in October, despite falling almost 8% from intra-month highs

Market Review

October saw most of the S&P500 companies report their third quarter earnings, with a few notable exceptions that are still due to report. Resilient earnings growth has supported global equity markets, climbing 2% over the month and breaking new highs. The ‘Magnificent 7’ led markets higher, with Nvidia, Alphabet and Amazon notable strong performers. Global fixed income rose 0.8% in October, with most developed market sovereign curves shifting lower. Credit spreads were broadly unchanged over the month, with the exception of high yield which did exhibit signs of weakness amid fears of contagion in private credit markets following a high profile default.

Fund Review

October was a positive month for the fund, buoyed by strong equity market performance and the notable position in Gold. Intra-month there were no outright sales or new purchases. However, we have been mindful of managing overall exposure to risk assets. In keeping with this, we did moderate our total equity positioning over the month, whilst remaining overweight. October was a notably volatile month for the precious yellow metal. Gold was up 4% in October, despite falling 8% from an intra-month high. There have been broader concerns that Gold is overbought near term, and whilst the performance of the asset has been notably robust in recent years, we continue to believe the longer-term structural themes supporting Gold, remain very much intact.

Outlook

As we approach the final months of 2025, the key focus of markets remains on the strength of the economy, the outlook for inflation and what this means for the trajectory of interest rates. The prolonged US government shutdown has reduced the flow of economic data meaningfully, clouding the picture for investors and raising uncertainty. With forward looking estimates suggesting the US economy could have grown as much as 4% in the third quarter and resilient earnings growth exhibited to date we remain constructive on risk assets, although do expect volatility to be a continued theme.
